#### MISSION STATEMENT

Develop and preserve an outstanding system of facilities, parks, and recreational programs for the Town of Coventry.

#### **CORE VALUES**

The Coventry Parks and Recreation Department will be a premier parks and recreation department in Rhode Island. We will improve the health of our citizens through programs and encourage staying active and fit. We will connect all citizens to our community by offering programs and encourage inclusion and participation. Finally, we will provide a wide variety of activities that encourage all segments of our population to use their free time both positively and productively, and promote life-long learning through recreational and cultural programs.

#### **REFUNDS**

Participants will only receive a refund when a program is cancelled due to lack of participants, facilities, or qualified instruction. Refunds for payments made by cash or check will be issued in the form of a check. Refunds for payments made by a credit card will be issued to the credit card minus a 3% service charge. A \$30 service fee with be charged for any checks returned from the bank. Registrations are non-transferable. Refunds take approximately 3-4 weeks to be processed.

#### **CANCELLATIONS**

The Coventry Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel a program due to insufficient registration, or any other cause, that prevents the presentation of an activity in an acceptable manner. If the session is cancelled due to iinclement weather, instructor illness, etc., a make-up date may be scheduled to honor the original number of sessions. Visit coventryrecreation.com ad our social media pages for the most up-to-date cancellation information.

#### LOW ENROLLMENT

Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment are not the best use of our limited resources. Classes with low enrollment will be notified that the class is in danger of being cancelled two weeks prior to the class starting. The actual class will be cancelled within one week prior to the scheduled start date and a full refund or account credit will be issued. The Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to reschedule, postpone, combine, or change classes. You will be notified via email or phone if your class is cancelled; otherwise plan on attending.

#### **MAKE-UP CLASSES**

All attempts will be made to reschedule classes that have been cancelled due to inclement weather, instructor absence, or other unforeseen circumstances. Typically, a program that meets weekly will extend another week at the same day and time. Check with your instructor to confirm. Classes missed due to participant absence because of scheduling conflicts or personal reasons cannot be made up.

#### **DROP-OFF PROGRAMS**

Parents/Guardians of children under 5 years of age participating in our programs are required to accompany their child(ten) to and from the location of the program (i.e. class rooms, gymnasium, etc.) and must remain on the premises should they be needed. Should a parent or guardian leave the area of the program, they MUST inform the instructor where they can be found, including contact information. This procedure has been established for the protection and safely of all children within parts & recreation programs.

#### PHOTO/VIDEO POLICY

The Parks & Recreation Department may make, have, use, publish, and reproduce photographs and/or video of participants for its record, public relations purposes, recognition and/or other projects related to the wholesome promotion of its program unless permission is denied in writing.

#### **INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY**

All classes (day and evening) will be canceled when Coventry Public Schools are closed. If Coventry Public Schools have a delayed opening, all Parks & Recreation Department programs will start on their regularly scheduled time, unless you are informed otherwise. In the event we need to cancel evening or weekend classes, it will be listed on our website and social media pages. We will also attempt to email participants who have registered for these classes.

**Ages:** The division is determined by the grade your child has completed as of 6/30/2024. This program is for youth entering grades 4-12 in the 2024/2025 academic year.


**Schedules:** Coaches will provide participants with schedules and t-shirts after the draft date.
