Registration is required prior to the start of any program unless otherwise noted. Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. The office is open Monday-Friday; 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Please note that there is a 3% credit card processing fee.

CANCELLATIONS:

The Coventry Department of Parks and Recreation reserves the right to cancel a program due to insufficient registrations, or any other cause, that prevents the presentation of an activity in an acceptable manner. If the Coventry Public Schools cancel or close early due to inclement weather, or any other reason, then all after school recreation programs will also be cancelled.

REFUNDS:

Participants will receive a refund when a program is cancelled due to lack of participants, facilities, or a qualified instructor. No refunds or prorating will be offered for classes missed by a participant for any reason. All cash payment refunds will be issued in the form of a check. Refunds take approximately 3-4 weeks to be processed. Credit card payments will be refunded minus a 3% processing service charge. A \$30.00 service fee will be charged for any checks returned from the bank. Registrations are non-transferable.

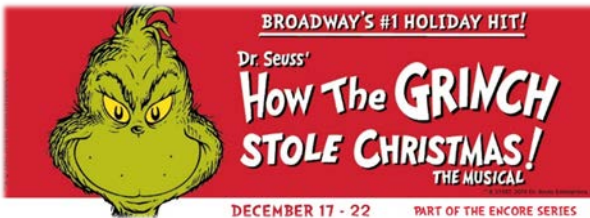

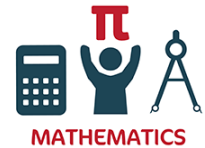
